

General Education/Youth Information

The Midway is a museum and you will be climbing ladders and encountering knee knockers, avoiding plane wings and other obstacles. For your safety the following is strongly recommended:

Make sure children and adults are dressed for an action-filled day.

- Walking shoes are required, no sandals, open toed shoes or high heels.
- Dress appropriately. Pants or slacks or recommended. The flight deck can be very breezy.
- Cameras are allowed.

Arrange for an adequate number of chaperones.

- One adult for every 10 students is required.
- An adult with a small child or infant is not considered to be a chaperone.
- Students must be supervised at all times, whether the class is touring as a single group, or is broken into smaller groups.
- Appropriate behavior is expected. Conduct problems will be reported to principals.

Check In:

- Please bring your confirmation letter with you.
- On weekdays a member of our Education Department will greet your group on the pier and will assist your group with check in and boarding.
- Upon check in at the ticket office, please have your confirmation letter, accurate group count and payment ready. Payment is to be only as **one** transaction.
- Please have your students assigned to a chaperone before boarding the ship.
- Your group will enter after admission is paid.
- Late arrival will impact the time allotted for your tour or program.
- Passes are not accepted as payment for programs or education reservations.

Parking:

- Buses may drop off and pick up groups in front of the ship, next to brow 4, but are not allowed to stage or park on the pier. Parking is \$7 per spot for cars up to 4 hours.
- Please inform your chaperones of the parking fee prior to their arrival.

Refund Policy

- We will do our best to reschedule your program. Full payment of the program fee will be charged for cancellations made less than 72 hours in advance.
- Cancellations must be submitted in writing, fax or email to the museum's Education Department. Please call the Education Office at 619-398-8271 for details.
