



## USS Midway Museum's Travel Professional Insider Tips

**Help your clients have the best visit possible by sharing these insider tips!**

- Visit the "Island Tour" on the Flight deck at the beginning of your visit. The lines become long in the afternoons and in the summer, visiting first will ensure that you are able to see all of the Midway that you wish to.
- Wear comfortable shoes the USS Midway Museum is a large museum so please be prepared to walk.
- Please dress for outside weather. Although most of the museum is indoors, there are sections that are outside and susceptible to outside conditions.
- Please allow 4 hours for your tour.
- Restrooms are located inside the Museum, next to the giftshop: The Jet Shop, and on the flight deck.
- There are more than 300 parking spaces alongside Midway on Navy Pier (owned and operated by the Port of San Diego) for vehicles only. Should those spaces fill up there is nearby parking: Metered spaces are available on city streets (\$1.25 per hour with a 2-hour limit). Downtown San Diego features more than 50,000 parking spaces. Some are within walking distance of the USS Midway Museum. Many are a short pedicab or taxi ride away.
