

# HIGHLIGHTS OF MIDWAY INSTITUTE


- ▶ Iconic Vietnam/Cold War era large warship
  - ▶ Central downtown San Diego location
  - ▶ Seminars on Cold War, Vietnam, Korea, and WWII in the Pacific
  - ▶ 2009: 1 seminar, 20 local teachers
  - ▶ 2019: 4 seminars plus other activities, 120+ national teachers

# WHAT INSTITUTE TEACHERS RECEIVE

- ▶ \$1000 stipend (two weeks) or \$500 (one week)
  - ▶ Travel and living support for those outside the San Diego area
  - ▶ Shipboard meals, parking, and many instructional resources
  - ▶ Numerous opportunities for personal interaction with faculty and veterans
  - ▶ Optional academic credit

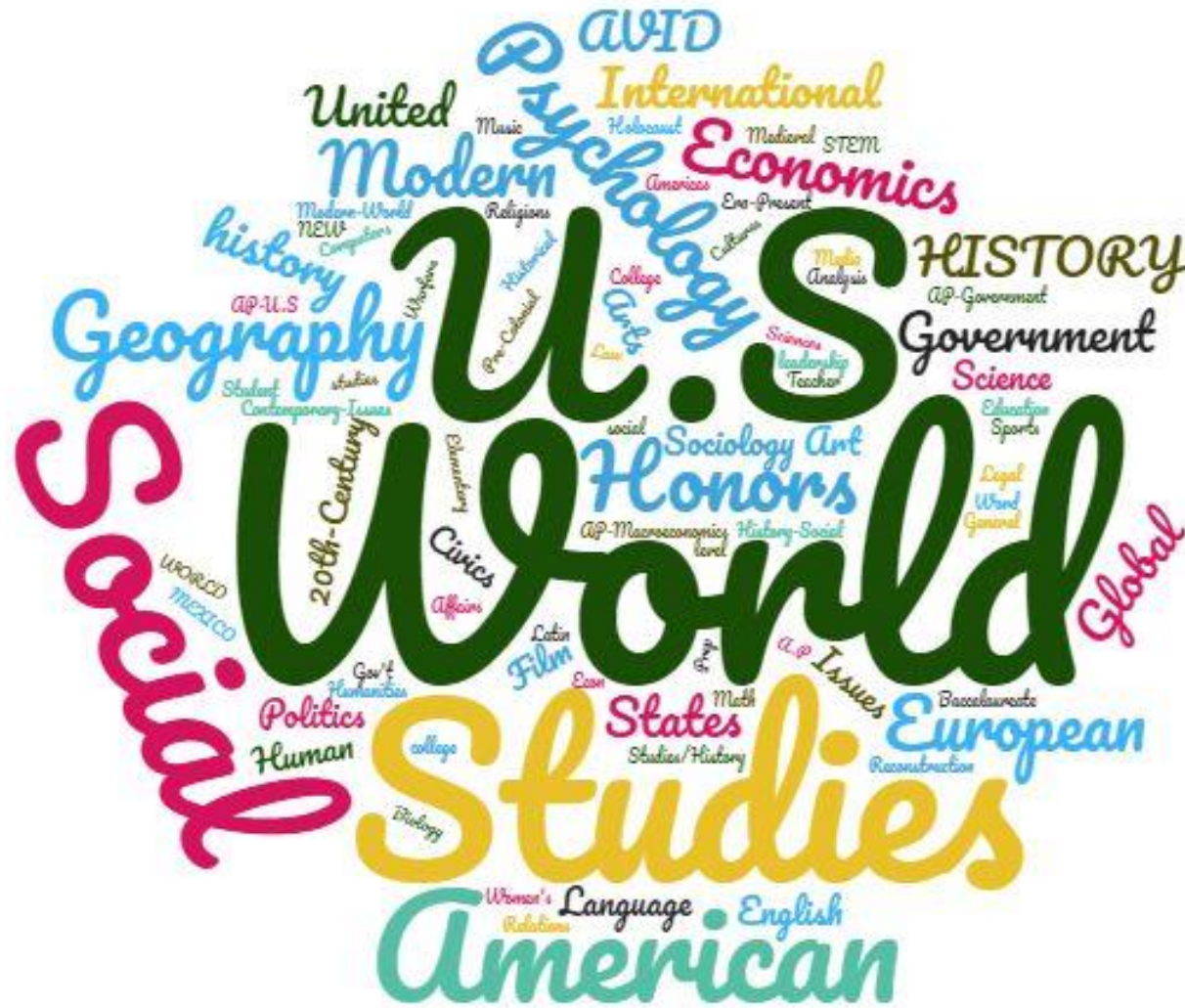
# MIDWAY METHOD

- ▶ Emphasis on diverse academic, global and cultural perspectives
  - ▶ Utilization of distinctive and uncommon primary sources, and of oral history
  - ▶ Discussion of both world and domestic events, and emphasis on classroom application
  - ▶ Connecting teachers to the wartime eras via extensive, specialized ship tours

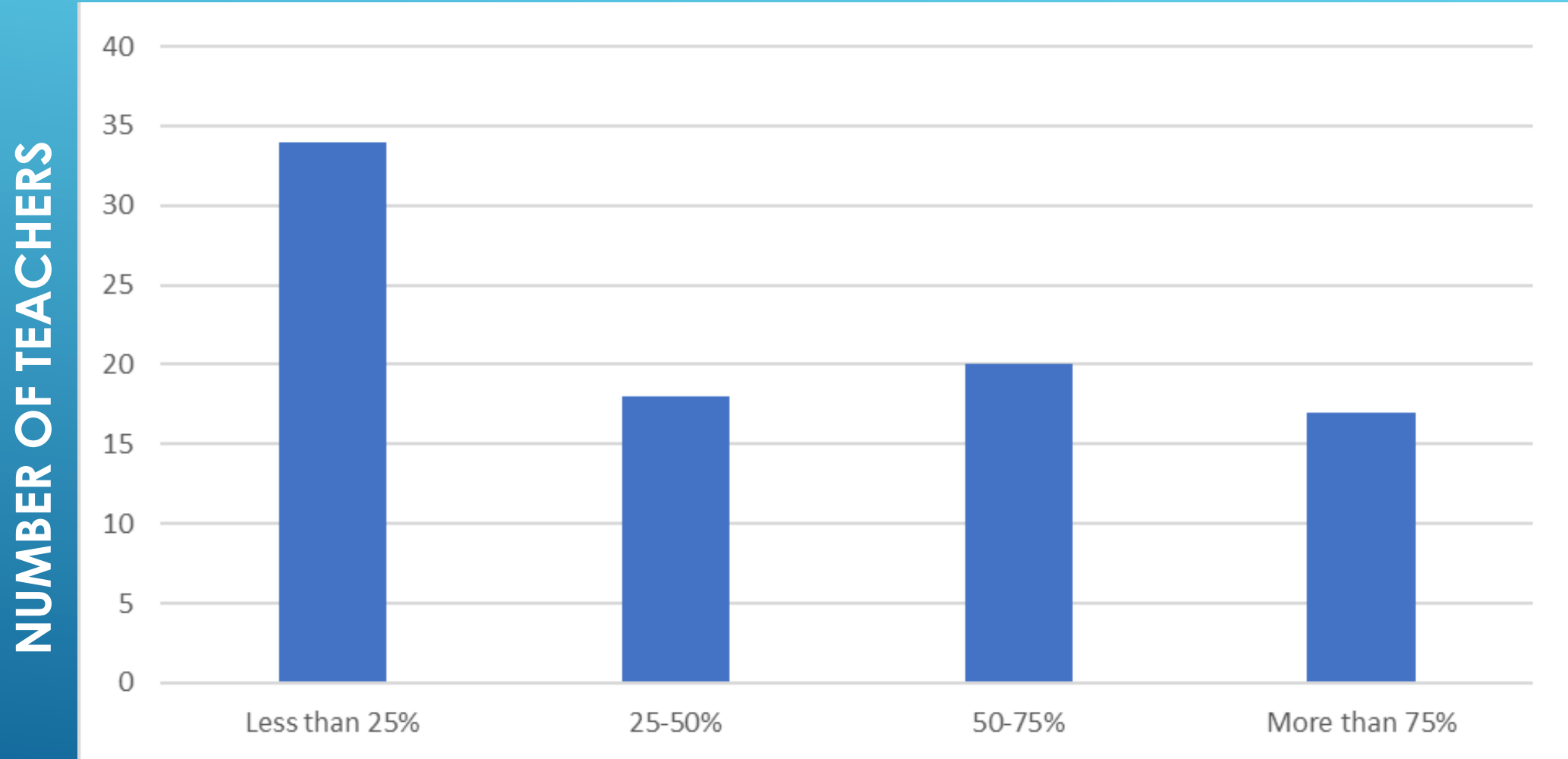
# VIETNAM/COLD WAR IN RED AND WWII IN BLUE ENROLLED TEACHER LOCATIONS—2018

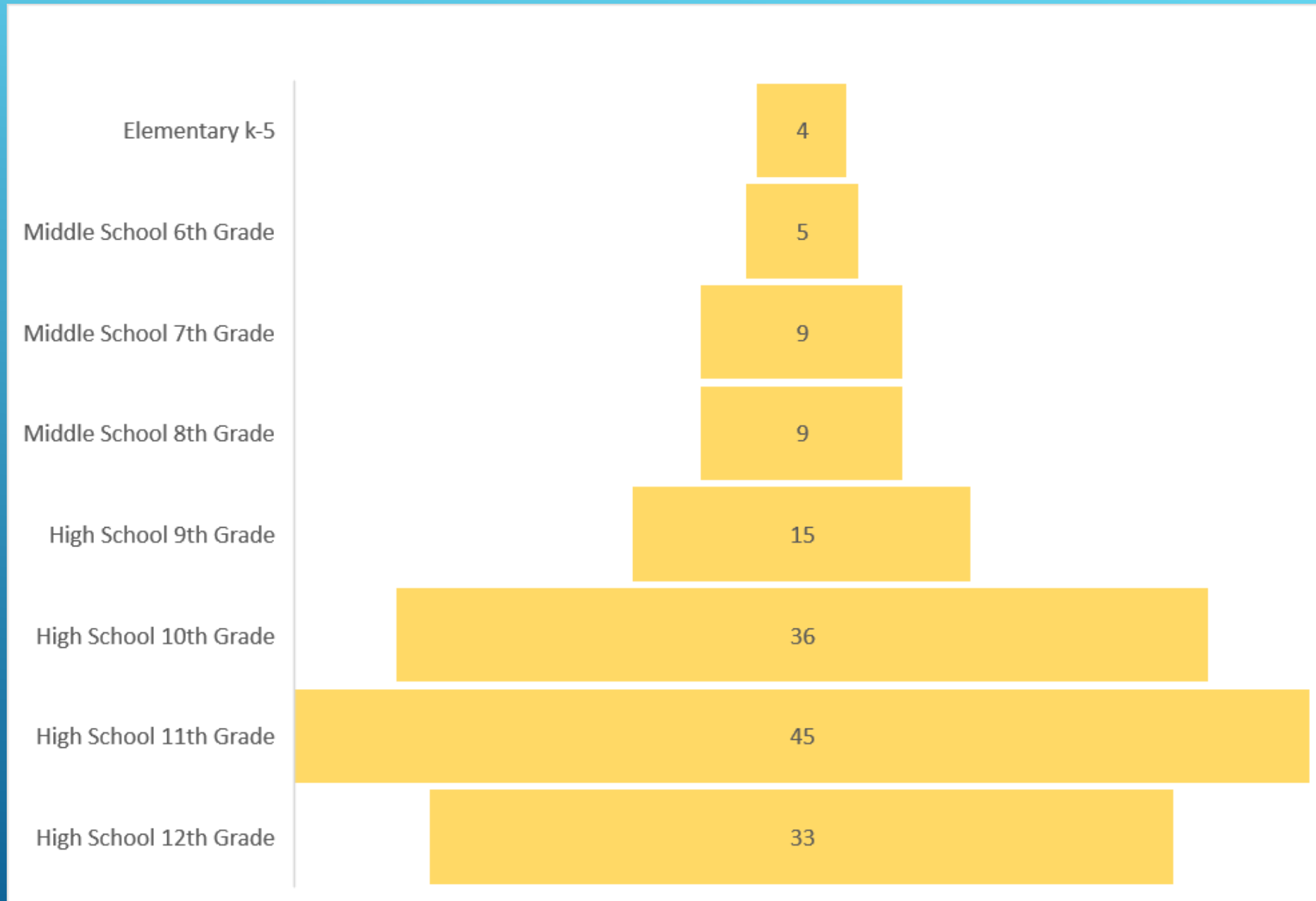


# TEACHER SCHOOL TITLE 1 PERCENTAGES



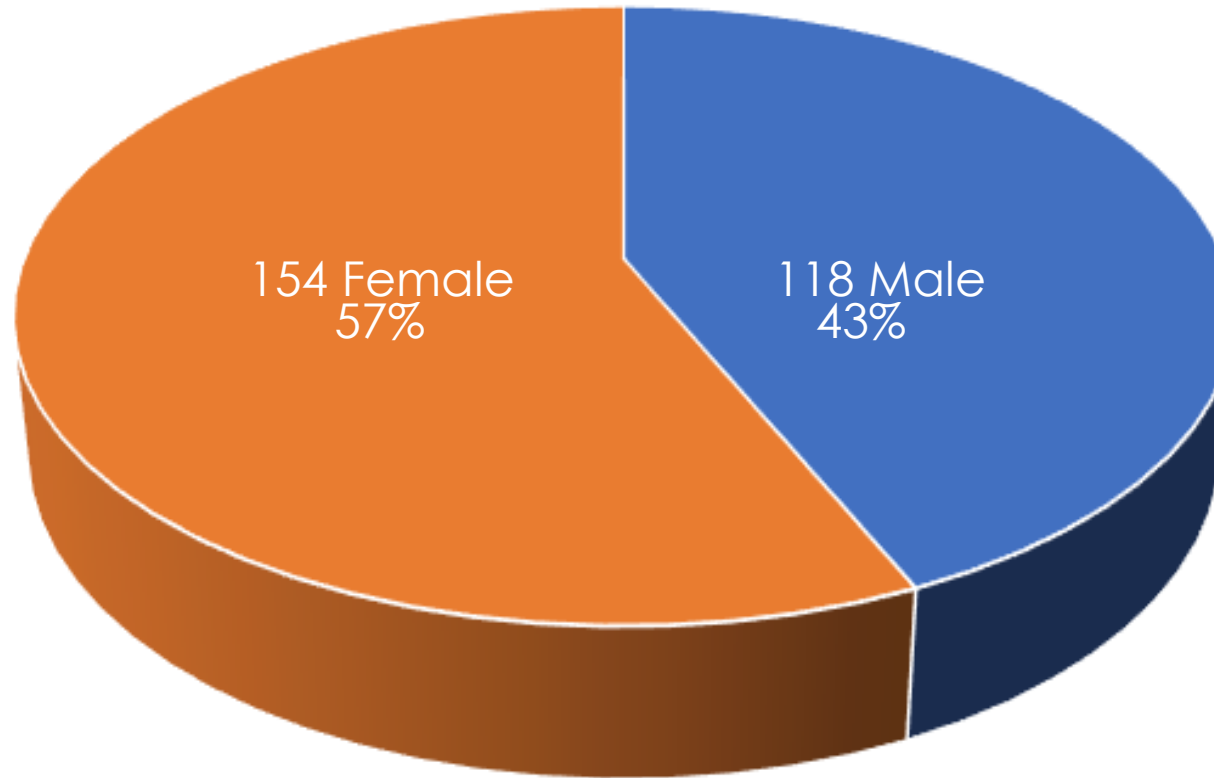
PERCENTAGE OF TITLE I STUDENTS AT TEACHERS SCHOOL

# GRADE LEVELS TAUGHT




Note: Many Teachers teach more than one grade level, each level taught earned a data point so more points are shown than total teachers
